After the first edition of the **IFAU 2017 – International Forum on Architecture and Urbanism** organised in December 2017 Tirana, the **Università degli Studi G. d’Annunzio Chieti-Pescara - Dipartimento di Architettura (DdA)** and the **Polytechnic University of Tirana – Faculty of Architecture and Urbanism (FAU)** are organising the second edition:

IFAU 2018 – International Forum on Architecture and Urbanism in Pescara, Italy on **November 8 - 10, 2018**, with the theme **“Fragile Territories”**.

IFAU 2018 – 2nd International Forum on Architecture and Urbanism aims to bring together leading academic scientists, researchers, and scholars to exchange and share their experiences and research results about all aspects related to **Landscapes, Cities and Architecture within FRAGILE TERRITORIES**. It also provides the premier interdisciplinary forum for researchers, practitioners, and educators to present and discuss the most recent innovations, trends, and concerns, practical challenges encountered and the solutions adopted for the **Fragile Territories in Cities in Transition**.

The Forum will concentrate on landscapes, cities and architecture located in contexts and territories that reveal their own fragility. The **second edition** is expanding the horizon by introducing a series of overlapping visions spanning the recently institutionalised Adriatic-Ionic Euroregion, now extended to the Balkan Region.

The nature of this fragility derives from multiple natures. There is a fragility of territories caused by natural phenomena (earthquakes, landslides, flooding, fires, drought, etc.) that lead to situations of seismic, hydrogeological and environmental risk characteristic of much of the Adriatic and Balkan regions. There is economic and social fragility, above all in inland territories, where living and working conditions remain precarious primarily due to depopulation, emigration and a widespread economic crisis. There is political and social fragility in territories that remain unstable and continue to suffer, even recently, from acts of war and terrorism. There is fragility in territories crossed by vast flows of migrants fleeing areas of conflict in search of an ordinary and peaceful life. There is religious, linguistic and ethnic fragility caused by atavistic and historic tensions in areas that have yet to establish a harmonious and shared existence between similar peoples of different faiths, languages and origins. There is a fragility of agricultural lands, many no longer able to compete with industrialised production and unable to maintain historic equilibriums between the landscape and what it produces. There is environmental fragility caused by pollution, growing amounts of waste and toxic emissions that irreversibly compromise natural and manmade habitats. There is cultural fragility in places where modernisation and globalisation have not developed in harmony with local

traditions and histories. Above all else, all of our cities suffer from the abandonment of central, peripheral and suburban areas that creates an increasingly more evident urban fragility that undermines the very meaning of places and cities. All of this is accompanied by the decommissioning of buildings, factories, manufacturing plants, warehouses and constructions of the most varied nature, which have lost their primary function and are left abandoned and waiting for a new life.

These fragilities – and others – are the object of this Forum.

The Forum will focus primarily on a comparison of disciplinary actions and research in the Adriatic-Ionian Euroregion (and beyond). The study will be extended to the entirety of the Balkan region, fast becoming a key territory for Europe and for relations between East and West and between North and South; more precisely between Europe and the Balkans. We must now think about a new cultural policy similar to the diagonal/transversal axis of the Adriatic that runs from the heart of Central Europe down into the East. This geographical transversality must become a cultural and political transversality capable of creating connections and integrating the experiences and knowledge developed on both shores of the Adriatic and, more in general, in territories where the Adriatic, the Ionian and the Danube serve as imaginary borders, and Venice and Istanbul the root poles of their culture.

Through contributions from colleagues and scholars at different Universities, the intention is to explore ***the history and evolution of public spaces, to study processes of spatial planning in territories and cities in transition, to define strategies for urban transformation and to confront issues raised by environmental and architectural sustainability***, all framed by an up-to-date and contemporary ***geourbanistic*** vision of the entire region. Culture and the strength of ideas are viewed as the principal tools for building bridges between knowledge and for rediscovering, in a new relationship between geography, urban planning and architecture, the key to interpreting the processes transforming territories and cities.

The Forum will be structured as a **CALL FOR PAPERS/CALL FOR POSTERS** subject to peer review by a team of professors from the promoting Universities.

All accepted Papers and Posters will be presented during the FORUM and included in a peer-reviewed volume complete with an ISBN code in the “Architectural Studies and Research” series published by Gangemi Editori. Only the authors of the **accepted Papers and Posters** will pay a **Registration Fee by October 15th 2018** following the indications stated below.

The Forum will be organised in 4 THEMATIC SESSIONS:

1. PUBLIC SPACES IN ADRIATIC AND IONIAN CITIES
2. FRAGILE TRANSITIONS: CITIES, PLANS AND PROJECTS OF URBAN RESILIENCE
3. PHENOMENA OF URBAN RE-GENERATION
4. SUSTAINABILITY FOR A NON-FRAGILE HABITAT

DATES AND PLACE

The **IFAU 2018 – International Forum on Architecture and Urbanism - FRAGILE TERRITORIES** will take place in PESCARA (Italy) at the Department of Architecture – Università G. d’Annunzio, Viale Pindaro 42, Pescara on **November 8th - 10th, 2018**.

The CALL for IFAU 2018 will be officially announced by June 10th, 2018.

The Forum has a wide Board of Scientific Advisors of very high level to guarantee the quality of the event. Internationally known Key-note speakers will be invited to the Forum for the lectures, together with academics and scholars who work within the field of research. The Detailed program of lectures and events will be published soon.
